

Day 1: Friday, April 14, 2023 Washington, D.C. - Tour Begins On a journey that takes you through Washington, D.C., Niagara Falls, and New York City, discover the quintessential sites of the East Coast. Your journey begins in the nation's capital: Washington, D.C. Immerse yourself in the epic story of America.

Day 2: Saturday, April 15, 2023 Washington, D.C. Experience the seat of American democracy with a guided tour of the storied U.S. Capitol Visitor Center. In the early 20th century, Pittsburgh functioned as a booming industrial capital by producing steel. En route to the city, stop for lunch at a charming, historic tavern dating back to the 1700s. After arriving in "Steel City," scale the side of Mt. Washington with a ride on the Duquesne Incline. Completed in 1877, this funicular and track were recently restored to carry travelers to the top of the lookout point. From the observation deck, marvel at the best view of Pittsburgh while learning about this illustrious city with a local guide. (B, L)

Day 5: Tuesday, April 18, 2023 Pittsburgh - Niagara Falls, Ontario, Canada As you journey to Niagara Falls, travel through the Great Lakes port of Erie, sheltered by Presque Isle Peninsula, a natural bay formed on the southeast shore of Lake Erie. Take in views of the lake on one side and Erie's wine country, the largest grapegrowing region east of the Rockies, on the other. This

Whether you're seeking thrills, romance, natural beauty, or some combination of the three, Niagara Falls delivers all that and more. Considered the second largest waterfall in the world, the falls are a geological phenomenon that formed over 12,000 years ago. While referred to as one unit, Niagara actually consists of three distinct falls – Horseshoe Falls, American Falls, and Bridal Veil Falls. It's said that 3,160 tons of water flow over the falls every second, traveling at a steady rate of 25 mph. Stand in awe and quiet admiration of this natural wonder. For a true sensory experience, cruise the base of the falls and hear the roar of the cascading waters while being enveloped in a cooling mist.

IDENTIFICATION

Travel within USA

For travel completed by May 2, 2023, all airlines will ask for identification when you check in. It is recommended that you carry a passport if you have one. A driver's license (with a photo I.D.) is also acceptable for domestic flights.

Effective for travel May 3, 2023 forward, the REAL ID Act standards for identification while travelling will be in effect. This means a standard issued driver's license used as a form of identification will no longer be accepted for domestic air travel within the United States. Instead, a Real ID compliant form of identification must be presented both at the time of booking air travel with Collette and upon checking in at the airport to board any flight. Any fees associated with changing a reservation resulting from a non-compliant identification will be the responsibility of the guest. IDENTIFICATION

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require a minimum of 6 months passport validity from date of return home. IMPORTANT: We recommend that our clients traveling abroad take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

To complete your tour, we <u>include</u> roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your <u>own air</u>, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.



Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis.

When reserving a triple room, please note it will have two double beds. Due to fire safety regulations, a rollaway bed cannot be brought into the room.

Effective immediately and through December 31, 2022 tour departures, **we require all guests to be fully vaccinated in order to participate in this tour.** Although destination entry requirements may differ, if you are unvaccinated, you will not be able to join us on this tour. All guests are required to bring proof of vaccination (official vaccination certificate in paper) on tour.
