DAY 1: SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2025

Portland

DAY 2: MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2025

Portland

Portland to Bar Harbor

Bar Harbor & Acadia National Park

Bar Harbor - Camden - Freeport

Head to Camden for some time at leisure. This quintessential town is home to the annual National Toboggan Championships and boasts many storefronts and 19th-century homes. Your scenic journey continues with a stop at a lobster shack to indulge in a must-try local favorite, the Maine lobster roll. Then, treat your pallet again during an Impact Moment! Visit the Maine Tasting Center to try a variety of Maine’s iconic foods such as: blueberries, seaweed, potatoes, and more. Later, arrive in Freeport, your home for the next two nights. Enjoy an evening at leisure. (B,L)

DAY 6: FRIDAY, OCTOBER 3, 2025 -

Freeport & Boothbay

Today, enter the natural wonderland of Coastal Maine Botanical Gardens, nearly 300 acres of grassy fields and woodland trails overflowing with floral hues. Enjoy some free time in Boothbay browsing this quaint, seaside town’s cute shops and restaurants. Tonight, toast to the end of your trip and bid Maine farewell over dinner. (B,D)
