ITINERARY:

DAY 1: AUGUST 7, 2027 - OVERNIGHT FLIGHT TO COPENHAGEN,
Your journey begins with a motorcoach transfer to Chicago O'Hare Airport, where you will board your overnight international flight to Copenhagen. Sit back, relax, and begin dreaming of the Scandinavian and Baltic wonders ahead.

DAY 2: AUGUST 8, 2027 - ARRIVE COPENHAGEN, DENMARK
Arrive in Copenhagen in the morning and transfer to your hotel. After check-in, the remainder of the day is yours to explore at your leisure. Wander along the colorful harbor of Nyhavn, visit the iconic Little Mermaid statue, or enjoy one of the city's many cafés and bakeries. Overnight in Copenhagen.

DAY 3: AUGUST 9, 2027 - COPENHAGEN CITY TOUR & EMBARK OCEANIA
This morning, enjoy a guided city tour of Copenhagen highlighting major landmarks such as Amalienborg Palace, Christiansborg Palace, Tivoli Gardens, and the historic waterfront district. Learn about Denmark's royal heritage, modern design culture, and Viking roots. Later in the day, transfer to the pier and board the elegant Oceania Insignia. Settle into your stateroom and begin your 10-night Baltic cruise in style.

DAY 4: AUGUST 10, 2027 - KIEL, GERMANY
Arrive in Kiel, a lively maritime city on the Baltic Sea. You may choose to explore Kiel's waterfront, Old Town, and maritime museums, or join an optional excursion to nearby Hamburg or the scenic Schleswig-Holstein countryside. Kiel offers a pleasant blend of modern harbor life and traditional German charm.

DAY 5: AUGUST 11, 2027 - BERLIN (VIA WARNEMÜNDE), GERMANY
Dock in Warnemünde, the gateway to Berlin. Consider a full-day excursion to Germany's capital to see iconic landmarks such as the Brandenburg Gate, Reichstag Building, Berlin Wall remnants, and Checkpoint Charlie. Alternatively, remain in Warnemünde to stroll its seaside promenade, lighthouse, and quaint streets.

DAY 6: AUGUST 12, 2027 - RØNNE (BORNHOLM), DENMARK
Largely rebuilt after World War II, Rønne still feels historic because even the new buildings reflect the older architecture. As a result, walking from more modern areas into the charming Old Town is less noticeable. Don't miss the 14th century St. Nicholas Church, one of the more iconic buildings on Bornholm Island, or the massive round-tower castle and its fascinating military museum in the south of Rønne. To better understand the island's seafaring and natural history, visit Bornholm Museum.

DAY 7: AUGUST 13, 2027 - GDAŃSK, POLAND

Step into the heart of Poland's maritime history in Gdańsk. Wander along the Royal Way, admire colorful merchant houses, visit St. Mary's Church, and browse amber shops. Gdańsk's Old Town has been meticulously restored and showcases centuries of Hanseatic heritage.

DAY 8: AUGUST 14, 2027 - VISBY, SWEDEN

Enjoy the lovely countryside beyond the towered walls and take in the view of this former Hanseatic League town before exploring its narrow, winding lanes, marvelous ruined medieval churches and impressive St. Mary's Cathedral. Or visit an intriguing Bronze Age burial in the midst of farmland and take in the cliff-top view of the precipitous coastline.

DAY 9: AUGUST 15, 2027 - RIGA, LATVIA

Discover Riga, the largest city in the Baltics and renowned for its stunning Art Nouveau architecture. Explore the medieval Old Town, Riga Cathedral, and Central Market, or enjoy the city's vibrant café culture. Riga's mix of old-world beauty and modern energy is captivating.

DAY 10: AUGUST 16, 2027 - AT SEA

Enjoy a relaxing day at sea as you cruise through the Baltic. Take advantage of the ship's amenities — savor gourmet dining, attend an enrichment lecture, relax by the pool, or unwind at the spa. It's the perfect time to recharge.

DAY 11: AUGUST 17, 2027 - STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN

Arrive in Stockholm, spread across 14 islands connected by bridges. Explore Gamla Stan (Old Town), the Royal Palace, Vasa Museum, and charming waterfront neighborhoods. Stockholm's blend of history, innovation, and natural beauty makes it one of Scandinavia's most beloved capitals.

DAY 12: AUGUST 18, 2027 - TALLINN, ESTONIA

Step into a fairy-tale setting in Tallinn, home to one of Europe's best-preserved medieval Old Towns. Walk along ancient city walls, visit Toompea Castle, and admire Gothic spires and merchant houses. Enjoy time to shop, dine, or simply wander.

DAY 13: AUGUST 19, 2027 - HELSINKI, FINLAND
