DAY 1: TUESDAY, APRIL 21, 2026

Charleston, South Carolina

DAY 3: THURSDAY, APRIL 23, 2026

Charleston to Savannah, Georgia

Later, journey along South Carolina's picturesque Low Country to the historic city of Savannah. This evening, take time to wander through Factors Walk and River Street, where former cotton warehouses now house stylish shops, cozy taverns, and inviting restaurants. DAY 4: FRIDAY, APRIL 24, 2026 Savannah

DAY 5: SATURDAY, APRIL 25, 2026 Savannah, St. Simons Island, & Jekyll Island

Before bidding farewell to Savannah, visit the Pin Point Heritage Museum to gain insight into the rich history and culture of the Gullah Geechee people. Then, travel to Georgia's storied Gold Coast and explore the charming St. Simons Island. Spend some time at your leisure, strolling through the village's unique shops and restaurants. Later, arrive at the exclusive Jekyll Island Club Hotel, where you'll settle in for a two-night stay. (B)

DAY 6: SUNDAY, APRIL 26, 2026 Jekyll Island

Nestled in the heart of the Golden Isles, Jekyll Island was once a favorite retreat for America's elite families, including the Rockefellers, Vanderbilts, and J.P. Morgan.
